Visit Mason City staff attends ABA Marketplace

VMC Project Coordinator, Lindsey James, was recently in St. Louis marketing Mason City as a destination for group tours during the American Bus Association's annual Marketplace event.

During her 3-day stay, Lindsey had the opportunity to attend education seminars and network with group tour planners from across the country. She also spent an entire day meeting one-on-one with pre-qualified tour operators during pre-scheduled appointments.

"The appointments went very well. People are very excited about all that Mason City has to offer. Many of the planners I spoke with are in the process of planning for 2016

and 2017 and hope to include Mason City in their plans. I look forward to following up with them and helping them plan their visits," says Lindsey.

It's estimated that 68% of the planners in attendance conduct business in the Midwest annually. Lindsey distributed Visit Mason City information to 54 group tour operators during the marketplace. She will spend the next few weeks following up with these prospects.

In February, Lindsey will travel to Chicago to represent Mason City at the Heartland Travel Showcase.

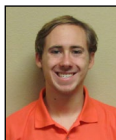

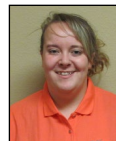

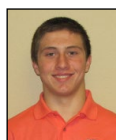
