## **TOUR ITINERARY:**

### **DAY 1 DEPART USA**

Make your way to the Minneapolis International Airport to board your overnight flight to Johannesburg. Enjoy in flight meals and services.

### **DAY 2 JOHANNESBURG - CAPE TOWN**

Connect with your flight to Cape Town. Upon arrival at Cape Town International Airport, you will be met and transferred to your hotel. Enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure. Overnight in Cape Town.

### **DAY 3 CAPE TOWN**

After breakfast, enjoy a half-day orientation tour of the city. See iconic buildings, snatches of history, and experience the uniqueness of Cape Town. You can take a ride up the cable car to the summit of the legendary Table Mountain, where you'll be able to see to the end of the world. Enjoy an exquisite view of the city and the surrounding landscapes of this southern most tip of Africa. Drive past the country's oldest building, the Castle, and a short distance away, the Company Gardens - both historically fascinating and well-conserved. Drive past the Parliament Buildings, City Hall and the Slave Lodge; you'll sense the depth of history via their distinctive architecture. Colonial scenery changes to colorful, as you move up the cobblestoned hills to the Malay Quarter, and marvel at the ice-cream colors of the quaint Bo-Kaap homes. In the afternoon, board a boat and cruise about 12 kilometers from Cape Town to Robben Island for a tour. Robben Island was the cruel home of Nelson Mandela for many years. It was a place of exile and imprisonment where rulers sent those they regarded as outcasts and troublemakers for nearly 400 years. It is a highly-charged emotional moment when you visit the site of this suffering and realize how far South Africa has come. Since 1997, Robben Island has been a museum acting as a focal point of South African heritage. Overnight in Cape Town.

**Optional:** Dinner at Richard's Supper Stage & Bistro - 'Kaapse Stories' - **\$60** per person

The one and only 'Cape show', 'Kaapse Stories from the Mother City', is played at this vibrant Cape-themed dinner theatre venue in Seapoint. The show transports the audience into the colorful and exciting world of the Cape and is paired with the wonderful culinary delights that Cape Town has to offer.

### **DAY 4 CAPE TOWN**

Enjoy a full-day peninsula tour of "The Fairest Cape!" You'll see for yourself where and why it earned this name. Sit back and relax while you cruise along the exquisite stretch of coastline known as Millionaire's Paradise - from Camps

Bay and Clifton, to the exclusive beach of Llandundno, towards the charming working harbor of Hout Bay. You may choose to embark on an up-close-and-personal Seal Island cruise (not included). Back on dry land, wind along the legendary Chapman's Peak Drive, hugging the cliffs and relishing the breathtaking ocean views, before arriving at the wild and beautiful Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve, an integral part of the world renowned Cape Floral Kingdom. Then, meander back along the coast toward the city, visiting the historic naval port of Simon's Town and enjoying the penguin colony at Boulder's Beach. Sir Francis Drake deemed it "The Fairest Cape of All", and you'll be sure to agree! Overnight in Cape Town.

### **DAY 5 CAPE TOWN - JOHANNESBURG - KRUGER NATIONAL PARK**

Morning transfer to airport to connect with your flight to Johannesburg and then travel into the Mpumalanga region by coach. Continue on through Graskop to Hazyview, just outside Kruger National Park. Overnight at Kruger National Park.

### **DAY 6 KRUGER NATIONAL PARK**

The world-renowned Kruger National Park offers a wildlife experience that ranks among the best in Africa. There are approximately 147 mammal species here, including the 'Big 5': lion, elephant, buffalo, leopard and rhino (black & white). Today begins with a morning safari by open-air 4X4 vehicle. This experience is a privilege beyond imagination. Kruger is one of the world's most famous game reserves with a glorious diversity of wildlife and birdlife. It is also renowned for its ever-changing African landscapes.
